

Executive Order amending articles 29 and 35; and adding articles 29 Ter and Quáter of INFONAVIT Law

This past January 6th, an Executive Order was published in the Official Federal Gazette amending articles 29, section VI and 35, first paragraph; and adding articles 29 Ter and 29 Quáter of the Law of the National Workers' Housing Fund Institute (INFONAVIT).

These additions allow employers to present requests and filings, and respond to payment and information requirements of the INFONAVIT in writing or through any electronic means. Therefore, the payment of contributions and discounts to this Institute may be made through electronic (on-line) forms.

Since the Institute will use electronic media for performing its job, it will be considered a certifying authority, and therefore it may issue digital certificates in order to make use of the Advanced Electronic Signature in the procedures under its responsibility.

The executive order entered into force on January 7th, 2016. In addition, pursuant to the second transitory article, the INFONAVIT will issue the relevant rules and instructions within 180 days from the entrance into force of the Executive Order.
